Information about Webinars

There are many different organizations providing webinars that are related to the field of Early Learning and Care. To ensure that a webinar will be eligible for PD hours the following documentation is required:

- The participant's registration confirmation email needs to be printed and saved as documentation. The participant's registration confirmation email needs to include the participant's name and/or e-mail address, host or facilitator's name, topic covered (topic must have early learning and care focus), time and date of the workshop.

AND

- An e-mail from the webinar confirming that you participated such as a "thank-you" e-mail needs to be printed and saved as documentation, if this is not available then the webinar's PD certificate can be used.

If a PD certificate for a webinar is submitted on its own along with the renewal application it will not be accept as original PD documentation.
